The Hills of Home and Grandpa.

Part 4- Assemble Your Film Set

Using the screwdriver, gently make another hole in the opposite (far) side of each of the figures. (See photo below).



This is for inserting a chop stick in each, which will make your figures into moveable puppets.

Don't insert the chop sticks yet!

Firstly, you need to work out the area where you want your puppets to be inside the set.

Using the screwdriver, make a hole in the left side and in the right side of the box, for each chop stick to go through. They should slide through, only just, with a snug fit.

Once the chop sticks have been put through the holes, you can now attach the puppets to the chop sticks.

Your puppets can now be moved around your set.

Perhaps Captain will lend their phone/video camera?



You could make up a script?

You could imagine a conversation (dialogue) between John and his Grandpa?
