Here is a photograph of another coin.



This is an American Quarter Dollar.

It has two dates on it.

Can you see who the person is on it?

It's John Muir!

Wow, how on earth did John start off, in 1838, as a wee laddie who loved scrambling over Dunbar Castle rock, then end up on an American coin in 2005?

Why not draw yourself on a coin?!



You'll need something round to act as a template.

Let's make it a bigger sized coin.

Now draw yourself in the circle doing something you love to do now.

Then draw a second 'coin' with you doing something you plan to do in the future.

Keep both your 'coins' somewhere safe until tomorrow.....
