

Paper Plate Turtle

If you don't want to make a turtle try adapting this to make your favourite animal – you could end up with your own wildlife park!



You will need:

- Paper plate
- Tissue paper (cut into squares)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Green colouring pencils/ paints
- Black marker
- Double-sided tape

Turn your paper plate upside-down and cover it with a layer of glue. Take some of your tissue paper squares and spread them over your plate.

Then draw and cut out your turtle's head, legs, and tail. Colour them in green and attach them to your plate using double-sided tape. Stick down your googly eyes and draw on a nose and mouth.

A turtle isn't the only animal you can make using paper plates, you could try making snails, lions, jellyfish, or even a unicorn!
