

Rainbows are Everywhere

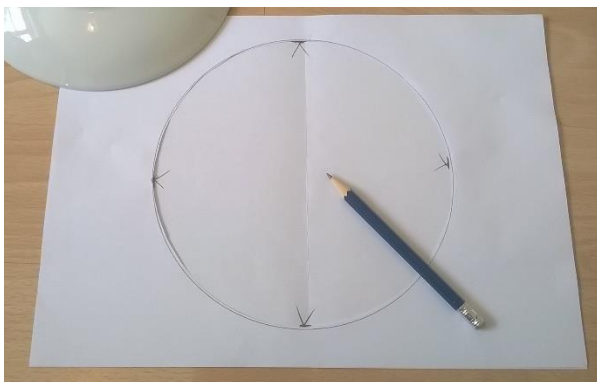
'Raindrops blossom brilliantly in the rainbow...'

Make a raindrop rainbow window decoration.

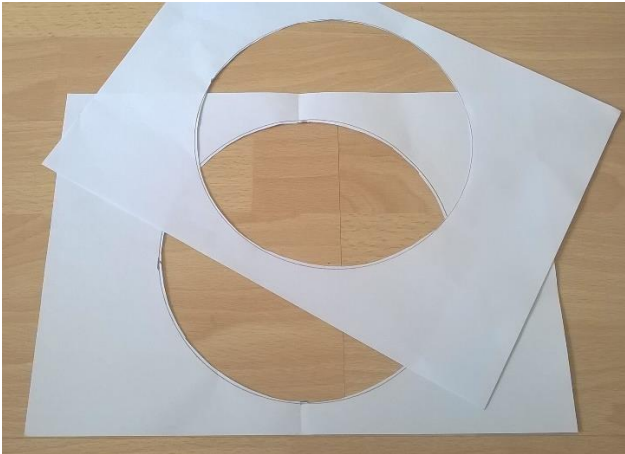
Here are the materials you will need (N.B. 2 x A4 sheets).



Cut out one circle. This is going to be your 'Raindrop'.



Put one A4 sheet on top of the other A4 sheet then mark where the second circle should be.



Using the same template (plate) cut another identical circle.



Cut strips from scrap paper and glue them across the circular hole.



Cut strips of coloured tissue paper and glue in place. This is going to be your white (polychromatic) light split into the colours that make it up.

Cut more strips from scrap paper.

Turn your raindrop rainbow over.

Glue the second set of strips across on the back of the first set of strips.



Stick the two sheets of A4 together with the two messy sides on the inside.

Your Raindrop Rainbow should look complete on both sides-perfect for a window.
